CORONA VIRUS : UAE STATUS AS OF JUNE 202

The UAE Ministry of Health and Prevention announced 410 new cases of the Covid19 coronavirus, taking the total number of cases in the country to 46,973, however, MoHAP also announced 304 new recoveries, taking the total number of recoveries to 35,469 as of June 26, 2020.



The UAE also announced that the National Disinfection Programme for Covid-19 had successfully ended and movement restrictions were lifted in Dubai and other emirates. However, people would still need to apply for Abu Dhabi moving permit if you are travelling from outside the emirate.

Authorities said to continue staying away from personal visits and social gatherings to ensure everyone's health and safety. People also need to continue observing social distancing measures and wear masks and gloves outside. By all means, there will still be penalties and fines imposed on anyone who violates guidelines which are in place to protect the society. Limit of three (3) people per car is still not lifted.

Flights in and out of UAE are gradually increasing. Residents who are planning to come back to UAE still needs to have an approval permit from ICA or GDRFA. The UAE is in the process of bringing those people back with safety measures in place to avoid the risk of a second wave. The country now has a system that will allow residents to fly abroad to certain low-risk destinations, thereby reducing the risk of importing more Covid-19 cases when they return.

Dr. Saif Dhaheri, spokesman for the **National Emergency Crisis and Disaster Management Authority**, said travel will be allowed to "**certain destinations**". Countries have been categorised as high, medium or low-risk. All citizens and residents will be allowed to travel to low-risk nations.

Only a "limited category" of Emiratis will be allowed to travel to medium-risk nations in cases of emergency, "namely for necessary medical reasons, visiting first-degree family members, or for military, diplomatic and official missions". Travel to countries deemed high-risk will be banned. The UAE is yet to announce this, but the active number of cases could be a factor.

People above the age of 70. Those with chronic diseases will be discouraged, but will not be prevented from leaving. People with the virus, those with a high fever (37.8°C and above) and anyone suspected of having Covid-19 will also be prevented from travelling.

While UAE have ordered that prayers be done at home to prevent the virus from spreading via communal gatherings in mosques.

The month of Ramadan is that in which was revealed the Quran; a guidance for mankind, and clear proofs of the guidance, and the criterion (of right and wrong). And whosoever of you is present, let him fast the month, and whosoever of you is sick or on a journey, a number of other days. Allah desires for you ease; He desires not hardship for you; and that you should complete the period, and that you should magnify Allah for having guided you, and that perhaps you may be thankful.

Because the crescent moon, typically occurs approximately one day after the new moon, Muslims can usually estimate the beginning of Ramadan.

Night of Power

Laylat al-Qadr is considered the holiest night of the year It is generally believed to have occurred on an odd-numbered night during the last ten days of Ramadan; the Dawoodi Bohra believe that Laylat al-Qadr was the twenty-third night of Ramadan

Fasting

Ramadan is a time of spiritual reflection, self-improvement, and heightened devotion and worship. Muslims are expected to put more effort into following the teachings of Islam. The fast begins at dawn and ends at sunset. In addition to abstaining from eating and drinking during this time, Muslims abstain from sinful speech and behavior during Ramadan fasting or month. The act of fasting is said to redirect the heart away from worldly activities, its purpose being to cleanse the soul by freeing it from harmful impurities. Muslims believe that Ramadan teaches them to practice self-discipline, self-control, sacrifice, and empathy for those who are less fortunate, thus encouraging actions of generosity and compulsory charity (zakat).

Muslims also believe that for the poor people who don't have enough food they should fast so that the poor can get food to eat. The aim of fasting now seems to be being compassionate towards the poor people.

Exemptions to fasting include travel, severe illness, pregnancy,

Suhoor

Each day, before dawn, Muslims observe a pre-fast meal called the suboor. After stopping a short time before dawn, Muslims begin the first prayer of the day, Fajr.

lftar

At sunset, families break the fast with the iftar, traditionally opening the meal by eating dates to commemorate Muhammad's practice of breaking the fast with three dates. They then adjourn for Maghrib, the fourth of the five required daily prayers, after which the main meal is served.

Social gatherings, many times in buffet style, are frequent at iftar. Traditional dishes are often highlighted, including traditional desserts, particularly those made only during Ramadan.

Eid

The holiday of Eid al-Fitr which marks the end of Ramadan and the beginning of Shawwal, the next lunar month, is declared after a crescent new moon has been sighted or after completion of thirty days of fasting if no sighting of the moon is possible.
