Three primary pillars:

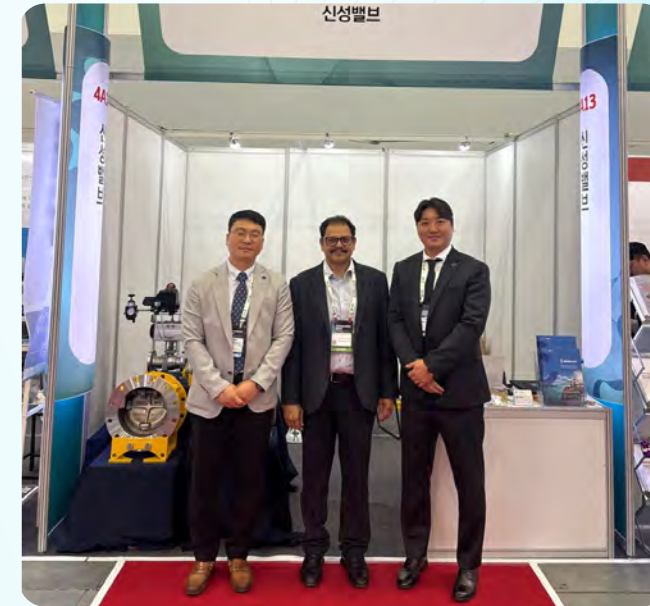
- Eco-Friendly Propulsion: A massive shift toward alternative fuels was evident.

# Marin Tech China 2025: Insights into the Future of Global

To put it simply, Marintec China 2025 was basically the "World's Fair" for the shipping industry. Held in Shanghai this December, it was a massive gathering where everyone from shipbuilders to technological geeks met to show off how the world's goods will be moved across oceans in the future.

It Was Immense Walking between 11 halls (N1-N4 and W1-W7) was a workout. We saw huge crowd moving through the walkways, It was basically the Olympics of shipping. Halls filled with high-tech engines, giant propellers, and advanced ship models. There were more than 2,200 companies.

## **Ships are "Going Green"**

How to stop ships from polluting?. For decades, ships have run on Heavy Fuel Oil. Now the focus shifted to:

- New Fuels: Companies showed off engines that run on Methanol or Ammonia, which are much cleaner.
- Electric Power: Think of it like a giant Electric Car, but for the ocean. They are using massive batteries and smart motors to help ships glide through the water using less energy.



## Smart Ships

Just like your car now has lane assist and GPS, ships are becoming computers that float.

- Self-Driving Tech: We saw more technology that helps ships navigate themselves to avoid accidents.
- Remote Monitoring: Experts on land can now watch a ship's engine performance in real-time from thousands of miles away to fix problems before they happen.

## The Cruise Comeback

Since people are traveling again, there was a huge section dedicated to luxury cruise ships at Hall N3. China is now building its own massive cruise liners like the “Adora Magic City”, who has been sailing successfully for over a year now, bigger sister “Adora Flora City” is under construction and they are designed to look and feel like floating five-star hotels specifically for Asian travelers.

I found China fascinating. Personally met about 200 people/ companies: Interest generated from 40 companies. Tariff exchanged with Headway Technologies (BWTSmaker). Negotiating after sales service and spare supply terms with Zhejiang Huayi Ship Equipment Manufacture Co. Ltd.

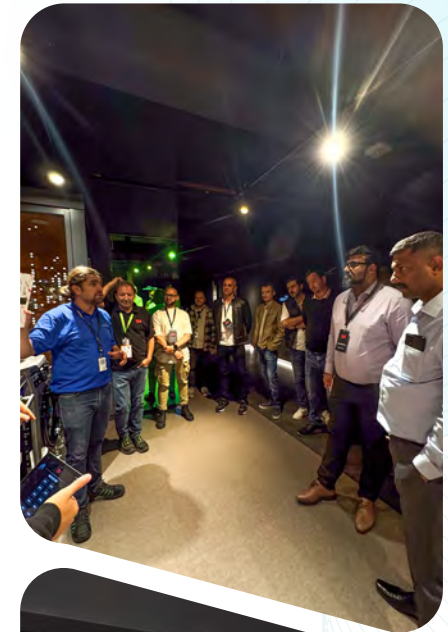


## 3M ASD Training- Istanbul

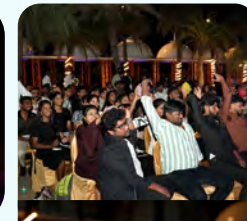


# Indian Office Annual staff Party

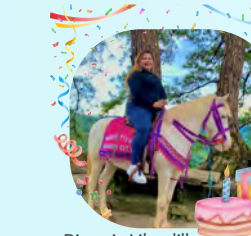

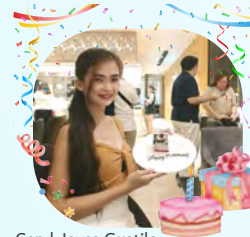
